

RANGE RULES/RANGE COMMANDS

(ALL FIREARM SAFETY RULES APPLY AT ALL TIMES)

Range Commands: ALL COMMANDS MUST BE FOLLOWED!

“Load Magazines”: Means load magazines only. Load revolvers, but the cylinder will be left open

“Load and Make Ready”: Means put the magazine in your firearm and cycle a round into the chamber. Close the cylinder in a revolver.

“Low Ready”: This means for you to point the gun down range at a low angle (base of the target)

“High Ready”: Point the gun on the target safety off finger outside the trigger guard

The fire command will be based on different factors. You will not hear “FIRE”. Instead the fire command will be the number of shots to make. i.e. “2” will be the command to place 2 shots into the center mass of the target.

“Failure Drill” or “Head”: Will mean to take careful aim and place one shot into the cranio-ocular cavity to stop the threat.

“Unload and Make Safe”: Means to unload the firearm while observing all safety rules, open the action and bench or holster your firearm as directed by the Range Safety Officer/Instructor.

“Cease Fire”: Means to stop firing immediately, make safe and bench or holster your firearm.

Anyone on the line can call a **“Cease Fire”** if an unsafe condition exists.

All firearms must be unloaded and the actions open when off the firing line.

Mechanical malfunctions/injuries must be reported to the range officer/instructor immediately.

CLOTHING

Hot Brass can cause serious injuries and burns. Do not wear loose fitting clothing. No tank tops, halter tops, etc. No open toed shoes or sandals. Shorts and other clothing above the knee will not be allowed.

EYE AND EAR PROTECTION

This is NOT negotiable. Appropriate eye and hearing protection must be worn while on the range. A hat with a brim is highly recommended to prevent hot brass from falling behind your safety glasses.

AMMUNITION AND FIREARMS

Only factory ammunition will be acceptable and firearms must be in good working order.

FOOD AND DRINK

No food or drink will be allowed on the range. (Consider hygiene before eating drinking or smoking)

GOOD JUDGMENT MUST BE CONSIDERED – SAFETY FIRST!
